

Kindergarten Supply List

- Backpack that children can carry themselves, big enough for 8x10 folder
(This is important, as one important element of our Kindergarten program is to foster developmentally appropriate independence in your child)
- Long sleeve smock (available for purchase at orientation for \$8)
- 1 package thick markers
- 1 package thin tip markers
- 1 package thin colored pencils
- 1 package multicolor crayons
- 1 package black ballpoint pens
- 1 package large pencils (ticonderoga beginner pencils)
- 2 squeeze glue bottles
- 2 thick glue sticks
- 1 durable RED two pocket folder (solid color)
- 1 durable BLUE two pocket folder (solid color)
- 1 box of tissues
- 1 box zip-lock storage size bags
- 1 box zip-lock sandwich size bags
- 1 change of clothing (shirt, pant/skirt, undergarments, socks, and shoes) with all items labeled inside of a labeled shoebox. This does NOT need to be a uniform set of clothing.
- Water Bottle

Please leave toys and snack at home. Personal toys, snacks, and other belongings can cause unnecessary distractions and should not be in your child's backpack when they arrive to their classroom. If there is something in particular that your child would like to bring, please talk to a classroom teacher.
